THE FACTS ABOUT HIV/AIDS...

- More than 1.1 million people in the United States are living with HIV infection, and almost 1 in 5 are unaware of their infection.
- In 2010, African Americans/Blacks represented approximately 12% of the U.S. population but accounted for 44% of new HIV infections.
- In 2010, the estimated number of new HIV infections among male-to-male sexual contact rose 12% from 2008. African American/Black males who have sex with other males continues to be the most seriously affected group by HIV.
- Women accounted for 20% of estimated new HIV infections in 2010.
- Hispanics/Latinos represented 16% of the population but accounted for 21% of new HIV infections in 2010.
- Injection drug users represented 8% of new HIV infections in 2010.
- Almost half of all new HIV infections in the world are among people under 25.

LIAAC'S MEMORIAL DAY RAFFLE RULES AND FINE PRINT
